

I have used Version 1 of Cinderella extensively when giving talks to schoolchildren which involve geometrical constructions, and I have also used it in an advanced undergraduate course to illustrate parallels and evolutes of plane curves. The new version is very much more powerful, but still easy to use, and the on-line documentation is good. I recommend it highly.
