IN MEMORIAM

Professor JACK CARNOCHAN (6 March 1918 – 7 May 2004), who has died aged 86, was a pioneering and influential British phonetician who worked and published primarily on the sound systems of major west African languages, such as Hausa, Igbo and Yoruba.

Carnochan joined the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) at London University in 1943 after leaving the army due to the loss of a leg in an air raid. In 1945, he became Lecturer in Phonetics. He used his knowledge of French to co-produce a phonological analysis of the French verb in the early 1950s, one of the first analyses of its kind within the Firthian paradigm.

In 1948–49, he worked in Nigeria on the phonetics of Hausa, Fula(ni) and Tiv. This research formed the basis for his breakthrough studies on Hausa phonetics and phonology. He later worked on another Chadic language, Bachama, which became the subject of many of his later publications.

He was appointed Senior Lecturer in Phonetics at SOAS in 1956, London University Reader in Phonetics in 1964, Professor of Phonetics in 1972, and Emeritus Professor in 1982, when he retired. From 1977 to 1981, he was acting head of the Department of Africa.

His core teaching contribution lay in experimental/articulatory phonetics and laboratory techniques, for example, palatography and spectography, and he taught specialist classes in the phonetics of numerous (and sometimes unrelated) west African languages, in addition to Arabic and Swahili, as well as courses in English for African students.

A knowledgeable and sympathetic teacher, liked and respected by his students, he was in constant demand at overseas institutions. A generous and gregarious man, he was a fine raconteur with a wealth of anecdotes deriving from his wide experiences.
