

Abbreviations

For referring to authors and their works, I have adopted the abbreviations used in LSJ. For the works of Dinarchus and Menander, the list was incomplete, so I have used my own: ‘Din. *Dem.*’ refers to Dinarchus’ *In Demosthenem*. For Menander, *Dys.* = *Dyskolos*, *Epit.* = *Epitrepontes*, *Mis.* = *Misoumenos*, *Pk.* = *Perikeiromene*, *Sam.* = *Samia*, *Sik.* = *Sikyonioi*, *Theoph.* = *Theophoroumene*.
