These pieces accompany Newcomb's article, 'Music In The Air: a theoretical model and software system for music analysis and composition'. *Daydreams of an Orange Cat* was composed in 1993 with version 0.63 of the MITA software system. *Substratum* was composed in 1993 with version 0.7 of MITA.

The Gown of Night and a short extract from *Like Two Branches* by Tsippi Fleischer

These pieces accompany Fleischer's article, 'Structural aspects of my music as illustrated in the tape work *The Gown of Night* and the cantata *Like Two Branches*'. *The Gown of Night* represented the State of Israel at the international ROSTRUM of composers, UNESCO, Paris 1989, and won the prize of the Canadian Electroacoustic Community, Montreal, 1993. It was published on CD No. 158 of OPUS ONE. *Like Two Branches* won the Israeli ACUM award, 1994. The full version is available on CD No. 3-1420-2 of SCHWANN-KOCH-AULOS.
