The editors of *Antarctic Science* are pleased to report the journal's continuing success as recorded in the Institute for Scientific Information Journal Citation Reports. For 1993 *Antarctic Science* had an impact factor of 0.796 and an immediacy index of 0.227. In the Environmental Sciences category it was ranked 32 from a total of 96 journals. In the Multidisciplinary Sciences category it was ranked 15 out of 62 journals.
