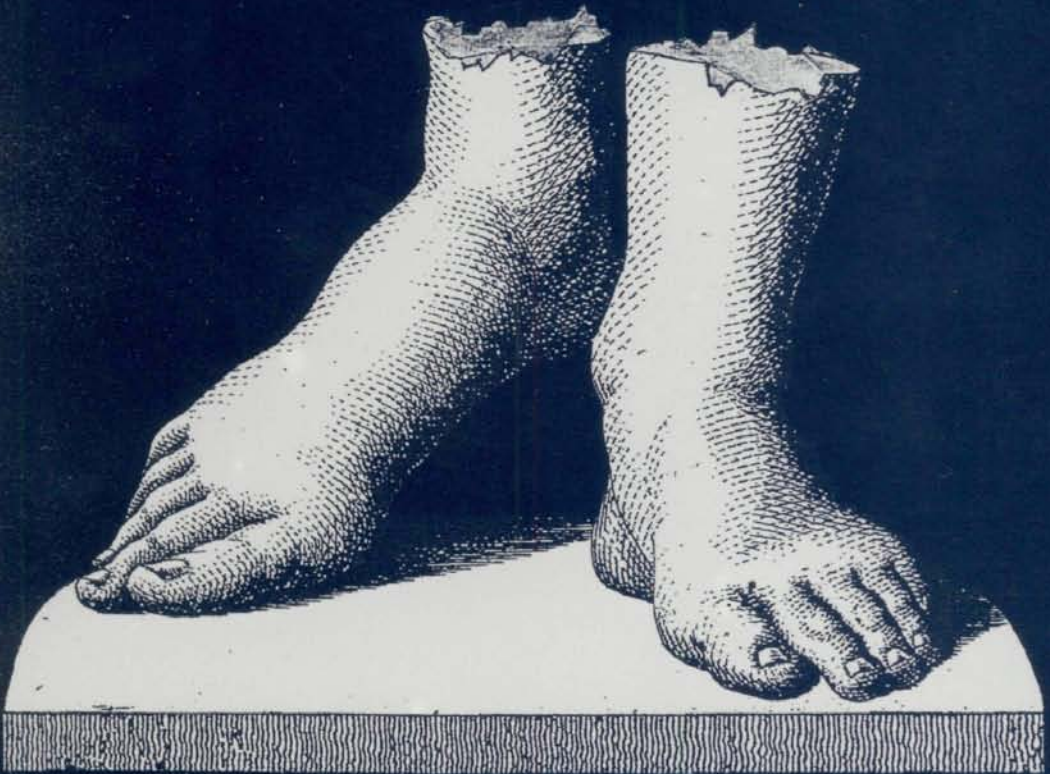

together with the decision on  
publication. It is a condition of acceptance  
that manuscripts have not already appeared  
in print (with limited exceptions for  
manuscripts which have been published  
in certain languages other than English).
