

ANNOUNCEMENT

7th International Palynological Congress

Brisbane, Australia, 28 August–3 September 1988

An extensive program of palynological symposia will constitute the scientific proceedings of the 7th International Palynological Congress to be held in a scenic subtropical setting—at the University of Queensland, Brisbane, Australia—during 28 August–3 September 1988. The more traditional geologically and botanically oriented topics will be covered, as well as some wider ranging, interdisciplinary symposia (e.g., forensic palynology, aerobiology in medicine). An interesting range of pre- and post-Congress scientific excursions in the Australia/New Zealand region is planned, including the Great Barrier Reef and New Zealand's past and present flora.

Papers are invited for presentation at 7IPC. Proceedings will be published in a single volume by the Australian Academy of Sciences. A list of topic areas and instructions to authors is available in the Second Circular. The deadline for receipt of abstracts is January 31, 1988.

7IPC is the first of its kind to be held in the Southern Hemisphere and coincides with Australia's Bicentennial celebratory year.
