ERRATA

In the Illustration of *Spokane* by Barry Carlson and John Esling in *JIPA* 30, there was a misprint in the first line of page 97 in the name of the language and in the orthographic text on page 101. The Native name of the Spokane language is Npoqínišcn. The correct orthographic version of the narrative is as follows:
