This paper is the fourth one produced by the Bonus and Valuation Research Group of the Faculty of Actuaries. The research was begun at the time when it was widely thought that levels of maturity payouts on with-profits policies might be significantly in excess of the level that could be justified by the actual investment earnings underlying the policies. The paper examines this claim and the effects that smoothing methods have on such policies. A life office model is used, the results are discussed, and conclusions on the general effects of smoothing are given.
