## COME AND VISIT THE PEACE PALACE LIBRARY IN ITS NEW HOME!

Together with the Hague Academy of International Law, the Library has moved to new quarters. After two years of drilling and digging, dust and noise, a new building has been constructed where the Hague Academy of International Law and the Library book storage department once stood. On 22 January 2007 the library opened its doors to the public.

Architects Michael Wilford and Manuel Schupp have designed a rectangular, three-floor, flat-roofed, redbrick building, in a very distinctive twenty-first century style, but at the same time smoothly positioning it next to the 'old' Peace Palace, with the new reading room literally bridging the gap. Via an enormous central hall with magnificent large windows visitors may turn right to the offices of the Hague Academy, painted a flaming red. An impressive oval-shaped auditorium with a view of the beautiful garden is ready for use. As one turns left from the foyer, stairs lead to the Peace Palace Library. The triangular wing-shaped reading room, including a mezzanine, thrusts one point into the Peace Palace, forcing a union between the two buildings, and allowing readers to both new and old reading rooms. There is room for approximately 130 students. Spacious study desks are available with modern computer connections and wireless possibilities. Needless to say, everything has been done technically to help visitors in their search through the catalogue, the databases, and all other digital and non-digital information. Study rooms are available for workshops, seminars, study groups, or special research projects.

The library's book collection, one of the largest in the field of international law, is housed in the basement. Special arrangements were made to make it fire-, flood-, and mildew-proof to ensure the safety of this unique collection, including the rare-book section, famous for its collection of the works of Hugo Grotius.
