Membership of the Association consists of:

Ordinary Members. The following shall be eligible for membership of the Association:

- (a) persons who have completed a course of postgraduate tertiary training which the Executive recognises as suitable training for guidance and counselling duties, and are performing or have performed duties of the same or similar nature to those recognised by the Executive as normal guidance and counselling practice.

or

- (b) persons who have other training and/or practical experience which the executive recognises as suitable for membership of the Association.

The number of ordinary members shall be unlimited.

Associate Members. An Associate shall be a person who wishes to subscribe to the objects of the Association, and to receive publications and participate in Ordinary membership. Associate members have no voting rights.

Membership/Renewal – 1990

- Ordinary membership: \$35.
This includes the AGCA affiliation fee of \$10 which gives full membership of the AGCA.
- Associate membership: \$25.
Associate members have all rights of QGCA membership other than voting rights.
- Joining/rejoining fee: \$20.
This fee is to be paid in addition to the appropriate membership fee. This fee is payable by all new applicants for membership and by former members who fail to maintain their membership each year.

Membership renewals fall due on 1 January each year.

The QGCA is a strong association working to provide professional services and support for its members.

Instructions for the preparation of manuscripts are similar to the requirements outlined in the Australian Journal of Psychology, with the following major exceptions:

- [i] Spelling should conform to the Macquarie Dictionary.
- [ii] Capitals should only be used for words which are capitalised in the Macquarie Dictionary, except where authors use capitals to distinguish subject groups or procedures (e.g. Pre-training group; Maintenance phase).
- [iii] Reprints. Contributors of accepted articles will receive a complimentary copy of the Journal and copies of their own article. Requests for reprints will be directed to the author(s).
