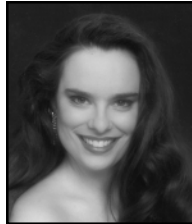

Recognizing her major contributions to international education and research at MIT, and her inspired leadership of the MIT International Science and Technology Initiative (MISTI), which she founded.

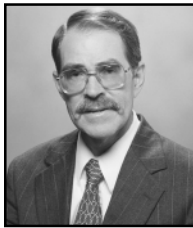

Recognizing faculty members who have created extraordinary research opportunities and devoted unusual time and effort to encourage, challenge, and develop undergraduate researchers.

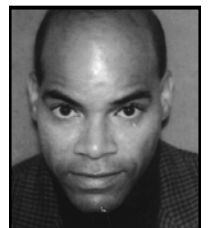

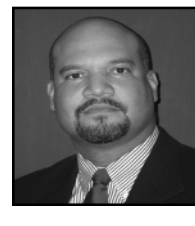

The Flame Award acknowledges UIC educators who have inspired their students. The Award is given by the University of Illinois Alumni Association.



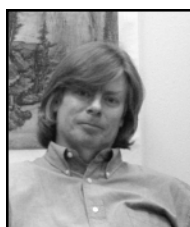

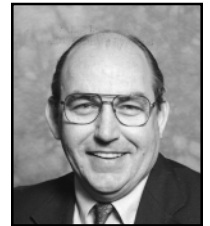
