Phyllis Goodhart Gordan, who passed away on January 24, 1994, will be missed, not only by personal friends, but also by numerous members of the scholarly community who had the privilege to know her.

She was an expert collector of manuscripts and rare books, following the example of her distinguished father, Howard Lehman Goodhart, and a generous friend of numerous scholars, institutions and societies.
