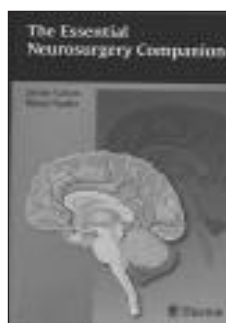
## **BOOKS REVIEWED**

**THE ESSENTIAL NEUROSURGERY COMPANION.** 2013. By Jaime Gasco, Remi Nader. Published by Thieme Medical Publishers, Inc. 1038 pages. C\$100.00 approx.

“The Essential Neurosurgery Companion” is a comprehensive study aide structured for the American Board of Neurological Surgeon’s examination. The text is divided into topic-based chapters and each chapter contains a list of questions on the left margin with the answer to the question on the right margin. Some answers are illustrated with imaging and histological sections or diagrams where appropriate. Topics ranging from pediatric neurosurgery to neuropathology and vascular neurosurgery are covered. There is a strong emphasis on neuroanatomy and a broad coverage of important imaging findings. Many common clinical questions, which are often asked in the clinic to the medical student or resident are included. The writing is clear and the text

is easy to ready for quick review; however, the weight of the 1038 pages precludes comfortably carrying this text around in a lab-coat pocket. In summary, this book serves as a broad review of basic concepts in neurosurgery in a question-and-answer format. It is suitable for medical students and junior residents to gain a wider foundational knowledge in neurosurgery.
