

Electroceramics X to Be Held in June 2006

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Electroceramics X, an international conference on electroceramics, will be held June 18–22, 2006, in Toledo, Spain. The conference is chaired by J.F. Fernández of the Instituto de Cerámica y Vidrio Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas [Institute for Ceramics and Glass at the Spanish National Research Council] and endorsed by the European Ceramics Society, Sociedad Española de Cerámica y Vidrio, and the Materials Research Society.

In the last decade, basic knowledge in the field of electroceramics has improved and its technological impact has been recognized. Ceramics, being important materials in the electronic, magnetic, and optical fields, are quickly entering the nanoworld, opening new and exciting possibilities.

Electroceramics X provides a forum for discussing recent advances and near-future issues for the development of this area. The conference will serve the com-

munity as a meeting point for researchers and engineers and will contribute to the dissemination of new ideas.

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
