The Chorus of *King Henry V* notes the difficulty of depicting battle on the early modern stage: "Can this cockpit hold The vasty fields of France? Or may we cram Within this wooden O the vary casques That did affright the air at Agincort?" (1.1.12-15). Artists like Frank Howard solved the problem with illustration, here depicting Henry V in full armor in the midst of a melee.
