This illustration by Louis Rhead was created for *Tales from Shakespeare*, by Charles and Mary Lamb (New York: Blue Ribbon Books, 1918). The Lambs' adaptation rendered Shakespeare's verse in prose, and eliminated language and scenes that they deemed would be inappropriate for children. The publisher placed this full-page image of Queen Thaisa being thrown into the sea *after* assurances that "Thaisa had never died, but ... fallen into a deep swoon" (350).
