Meadows' pencil sketches were translated into wood engravings for William S. Orr's 1846 edition of *The Works of Shakspeare ... illustrated with engravings on wood, from designs by Kenny Meadows*. Meadows' illustrations were a key selling feature of the edition. The jewellery, faintly visible in the pencil sketch, here illustrates the missing key to telling one Antipholus from another. Courtesan: "Give me the ring of mine you had at dinner Or, for my diamond, the chain you promised, And I'll be gone, sir, and not trouble you" (4.3.70-72).
