Johann Heinrich Ramberg was a German painter who traveled to London at the behest of George III; their mutual connection was Ramberg's birthplace, Hanover, of which the English king was Elector. While his oeuvre includes many caricatures of the king, he also painted scenes from Shakespeare, like this watercolor of Act 4, Scene 3 of *Timon of Athens*.
