Hubert François Gravelot's engraving illustrates a moment of *The Third Part of King Henry VI* that demonstrates the horrors of civil war while condemning Henry VI's leadership. Henry observes a grieving son discover he has killed his father, and another grieving father discover he has killed his son; in response, the king claims to be more devastated than either because of the destruction wrought upon his country by the civil war.
